

Rehab Services/ Home Health Services Registered Nurse

Schedule: Approximately 4-5 days per week, shift start as early as 7 a.m. plus every 4th weekend

Reports To: Home Health Coordinator and Cardiac Rehab Supervisor

Job Summary: This position delivers excellent nursing care in the patient's own home. Responsible for planning, coordinating and documenting care for an assigned caseload of patients. Delivers outpatient diabetes education, anticoagulation clinic cardiac/pulmonary rehab services.

Essential Job Functions:

- Delivery of Coumadin, INR testing, and Cardiac patient care through the process of assessment, planning, implementation, evaluation, coordination of nursing care and patient education based on established clinical nursing practice and protocol to ensure efficient patient care delivery and patient outcomes.
- Monitor rehabilitation exercise sessions, identify cardiac rhythms, detect and treat arrhythmias, assessment during exercise activities, risk factor modification, medication management and patient education.
- Perform Diabetes self-management education and support helping patients with diabetes navigate daily decisions and activities to help improve health outcomes.
- Facilitate knowledge, coping skills and behaviors of the patient for self-care of chronic disease.
- Assist with Community Health Promotion and Prevention programs.
- Communicate effectively to the public the philosophy and goals of Antelope Memorial Hospital, Home Health Department and Rehabilitation Services in a positive and welcoming manner.
- Adjust working hours according to the needs of the department and available every third weekend for Home Healthcare.

Home Health Services

Essential Job Functions:

- Make initial home based and rehabilitation based evaluation visits identifying specific and individual needs of the patient.
- Develop a written plan of care for each patient, evaluate the patient needs and assess financial and psychosocial needs of the patient.
- Assess patient's condition, reevaluate, and update individual plan of care and provide skilled nursing care and communication to their provider as necessary.
- Obtain necessary provider orders and collaborate with the provider as patient needs indicate.
- Draw and deliver laboratory blood work as ordered by provider.
- Teach patient and family on IV therapy in the home.
- Instruct and educate patients and family about all medications in the home.
- Become familiar with dressing wounds and wound VAC therapy.
- Monitor safety in the home.

- Knowledgeable in OASIS charting preferred.

Education/Experience

Must be a graduate of an accredited School of Nursing. Must possess a current RN license in the State of Nebraska.

Must possess a current driver's license and excellent driving record.

BLS and ACLS certification required.

Certified Diabetes Educator, preferred if possible.

Must have a thorough knowledge of the use and care of instruments, equipment and supplies related to nursing.

Must have a thorough knowledge of theory, practice and principles of medical asepsis.
