Summary:

The primary purpose of a Phlebotomist/Laboratory Assistant is to perform venipunctures and capillary sticks competently and expediently, have thorough knowledge of test requirements, perform clerical duties, perform waived or moderately complex tests, and to assist the Medical Technologist in patient testing and reporting; as defined by Antelope Memorial Hospital policy and procedure manuals, safety manual, and in accordance with current applicable federal, state, and local standards, guidelines and regulations, and as directed by the Laboratory Manager or Medical Technologist, to assure that the highest degree of quality care can be maintained at all times.
